A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT
PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO DIRECT THE GOVERNOR TO
CONDUCT ORGANIZATIONAL AND STAFFING ANALYSES OF STATE
AGENCIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Governor shall conduct organizational and staffing analyses
of State agencies. The analyses shall use the following guidelines:

- (1) Eliminate one-on-one reporting relationships at middle management
and supervisory levels.
- (2) Achieve spans of control of three to six, with a span of control of three
applying to highly technical, policy-sensitive, or nonrepetitive
functions.
- (3) Consolidate units with small numbers of staff into larger, more
efficient units.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
