A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT FORMER LEGISLATORS WAIT TWO YEARS
BEFORE SERVING ON THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY
OF NORTH CAROLINA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 116-7(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) From and after July 1, 1973, no member of the General Assembly or officer or employee of the State or of any constituent institution or spouse of any such member, officer or employee may be a member of the Board of Governors. Any member of the Board of Governors who is elected or appointed to the General Assembly or who becomes an officer or employee of the State or of any constituent institution or whose spouse is elected or appointed to the General Assembly or becomes such officer or employee shall be deemed thereupon to resign from his membership on the Board of Governors. A former member of the General Assembly shall wait two full years from the date of leaving the General Assembly before being elected or appointed to the Board of Governors."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to elections or appointments made on or after this date.
