A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT
PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO MAINTAIN THE CURRENT
TUITION LEVEL FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA COMMUNITY COLLEGE
SYSTEM.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. It is the goal of the General Assembly that students in the North Carolina Community College System pay tuition and required fees at the rate of approximately twenty percent (20%) of the cost of education. The tuition of students in the North Carolina Community College System shall be increased proportionately when the cost of education justifies an increase in tuition.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
