2 AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A GOVERNMENT PERFORMANCE AUDIT

3 COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION TO REQUIRE PERIODIC

4 INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY BRIEFINGS FOR EXECUTIVE, JUDICIAL,

AND LEGISLATIVE OFFICIALS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Information Resources Management Commission (hereafter referred to as "IRMC") shall prepare and adopt a plan for sponsoring periodic briefings for senior executive agency officials, senior judicial branch officials, and members of the General Assembly on major topics, issues, trends, and developments in information technology.

- Sec. 2. The IRMC shall present the plan for the briefings to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations not later than July 1, 1993, and shall implement the plan, incorporating where possible and practicable any revisions suggested by the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations, immediately after the presentation.
- Sec. 3. The IRMC shall prepare and deliver a written report to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations not later than December 31, 1993, listing (i) the number of such briefings held during 1993, (ii) a brief description of the contents of the briefings, (iii) a list of persons from the three branches of government who attended the meetings, (iv) an evaluation of the effectiveness of the meetings, and (v) plans for future meetings.
 - Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
