AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO REQUIRE PLANS FOR CONTINUOUS UPDATES OF CERTAIN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY POSITION DESCRIPTIONS.

Section 1. The Information Resources Management Commission (hereafter referred to as "IRMC"), working in coordination with the Office of State Personnel and the personnel officers in the executive agencies, shall develop a written plan for continuously updating information technology position descriptions at the State Information Processing Services and all executive agencies to reflect current qualifications requirements for those positions. The IRMC shall present the results of the initial updating efforts and the plan for continuously revising and updating the position descriptions to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations not later than December 31, 1993.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
