A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT
2 PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO REQUIRE THE GENERAL
3 ASSEMBLY TO DEVELOP A PROCESS FOR MULTIYEAR FUNDING OF
4 TECHNOLOGY PROJECTS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. The Fiscal Research Division of the Legislative Services Office
8 shall develop a procedure for funding information technology and telecommunications
9 projects that extend more than two years. The procedure shall include
10 recommendations for any needed changes in the rules of the Senate and House of
11 Representatives, changes in the operation and procedures of budget, appropriations, and
12 finance committees, and changes in the statutes that would be necessary to encourage or
13 permit funding information systems and telecommunications projects that extend more
14 than two years.

15 Sec. 2. The Fiscal Research Division shall deliver its draft procedure for
16 approval to the Legislative Services Commission not later than December 31, 1993.

17 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
