The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Fiscal Research Division of the Legislative Services Office shall develop a procedure for funding information technology and telecommunications projects that extend more than two years. The procedure shall include recommendations for any needed changes in the rules of the Senate and House of Representatives, changes in the operation and procedures of budget, appropriations, and finance committees, and changes in the statutes that would be necessary to encourage or permit funding information systems and telecommunications projects that extend more than two years.

Sec. 2. The Fiscal Research Division shall deliver its draft procedure for approval to the Legislative Services Commission not later than December 31, 1993.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
