A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT
2 PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO REQUIRE A PLAN FOR
3 RELOCATING CERTAIN TECHNICAL STAFF TO THE STATE
4 INFORMATION PROCESSING SERVICES.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. The Information Resources Management Commission (hereafter
8 referred to as "IRMC") shall develop a plan for relocating information systems
9 technical staff positions, including but not limited to computer programmers, systems
10 analysts, database administrators, and other data processing specialists, from the
11 agencies in which they now work to the State Information Processing Services wherever
12 feasible.

13 Sec. 2. The plan shall detail (i) the financial savings of each proposed
14 relocation and (ii) other benefits of the proposed centralization, and (iii) projected direct
15 and indirect costs to the State of the proposed centralization.

16 Sec. 3. The IRMC shall present this plan to the Joint Legislative Commission
17 on Governmental Operations not later than December 31, 1993.

18 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
