AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT

PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO USE COST-EFFICIENT DELIVERY

SYSTEMS FOR TEACHER STAFF DEVELOPMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

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Section 1. The Department of Public Instruction shall evaluate the use of existing and planned telecommunications and long-distance learning systems for teacher staff development to limit expenditures for travel and associated costs. This study shall also evaluate the use of alternative delivery systems such as courses offered through the community colleges and university departments of education. The Department shall report the results of its study to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee prior to March 15, 1994.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
