2 AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT
3 PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO ESTABLISH A SCHOOL STAFF
4 DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY GROUP TO PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS
5 REGARDING STAFF DEVELOPMENT NEEDS TO THE SUPERINTENDENT
6 OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall establish a staff
9 development advisory group to provide recommendations regarding staff development
10 needs. The group shall consist of eight to twelve representatives of local school
11 administrative units, including small units and units served by each of the technical
12 assistance centers. The Superintendent shall provide Department personnel to assist the
13 advisory group in its work. Based on the recommendations of the advisory group, the
14 Superintendent shall set staff development priorities and communicate those priorities to
15 the local school administrative units.

16 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
