A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT
PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO DIRECT THE STATE BOARD OF
EDUCATION TO DEVELOP A STRATEGIC PLAN FOR TEACHER STAFF
DEVELOPMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The State Board of Education shall develop a strategic plan for teacher staff development that identifies the types of training that are necessary at each level to achieve the desired changes in teacher activities. The plan shall address identified needs, goals and objectives, strategies, performance measurements, implementation plans, and cost benefit analyses.

The State Board shall also determine the cost of achieving the desired results.

The State Board shall report prior to March 15, 1994, to the Joint Education Oversight Committee on the strategic plan that it develops.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
