1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO DEVELOP A COMPREHENSIVE 3 4 NEEDS ASSESSMENT FOR ALL PEOPLE WITH DEVELOPMENTAL 5 DISABILITIES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 The Department of Human Resources shall develop a 7 Section 1. comprehensive assessment of service and program needs for all people with 8 developmental disabilities. This needs assessment shall be preceded by the use of an 9 effective data collection system. The needs assessment shall include: 10 Consideration of individuals who are unserved and underserved; 11 (1) 12 **(2)** Establishment of a statewide automated tracking system for all people 13 with disabilities; and Evaluation of the needs of people with developmental disabilities 14 (3) living in domiciliary care facilities. 15 Sec. 2. The Department shall report the needs assessment to the appropriate 16 House and Senate Appropriations subcommittees of the 1993 General Assembly by 17 18 May 1, 1994.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
