A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT
PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE FOR THE ADOPTION OF RULES BY
THE STATE PERSONNEL COMMISSION REGARDING STATE LAW
ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Article 12D of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by
adding a new section to read:

"§ 143-166.40B. When sworn law enforcement officer required.

The State Personnel Commission shall issue rules and procedures for determining
when a vacant position in State government employment shall be filled by a State
employee who is a sworn law enforcement officer and who requires the powers of a
sworn law enforcement officer in order to carry out the essential duties of his or her
position."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
