A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT
2 PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO TRANSFER SOME OF THE
3 INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS FUNCTIONS FROM THE
4 DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO OTHER STATE AGENCIES.
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6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. The federal/State relations component of Intergovernmental
8 Relations in the Department of Administration is transferred to the Governor's Office.
9 This transfer has all the elements of a Type I transfer, as defined in G.S. 143A-6.

10 The Director of the Budget shall resolve all conflicts regarding the transfer
11 mandated by this section. Position 4101-0100-0000-031 shall be eliminated and the
12 base budget appropriation for the 1993-94 fiscal year and for the 1994-95 fiscal year
13 shall be decreased by thirty-three thousand five hundred eighteen dollars (\$33,518)
14 because of the elimination of the position.

15 Sec. 2. The State/local relations component of Intergovernmental Relations in
16 the Department of Administration is transferred to the Department of Commerce. This
17 transfer has all the elements of a Type I transfer, as defined in G.S. 143A-6.

18 The Director of the Budget shall resolve all conflicts regarding the transfer
19 mandated by this section. Position 4101-0000-0000-013 shall be eliminated and the
20 base budget appropriation for the 1993-94 fiscal year and for the 1994-95 fiscal year
21 shall be decreased by thirty-three thousand five hundred eighteen dollars (\$33,518)
22 because of the elimination of the position.

23 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
