A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT
PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO HELP SCHOOLS IMPLEMENT
THE PERFORMANCE-BASED ACCOUNTABILITY PROGRAM AND END-
OF-COURSE AND END-OF-GRADE TESTING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education, Department of Public Instruction, the sum of three hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$360,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$360,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to augment the Technical Assistance Center staffs with regional assessment coordinators and accountability experts to help local school administrative units implement the Performance-based Accountability Program and the end-of-course and end-of-grade tests. The Department shall intensify the staff development and communications program to promote the outcomes-based focus of these programs and to assist users of data with interpreting and using the evaluative data.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
