A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
RESOURCES FOR A GRANT-IN-AID TO THE CARING PROGRAM FOR
CHILDREN.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be used as a grant-in-aid to the Caring Program for Children, Inc., to purchase health care for children who do not qualify for the Medicaid Program.

Sec. 2. The Department of Human Resources, in cooperation with the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, shall administer the grant-in-aid program.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
