1 A SENATE RESOLUTION HONORING THE FOUNDERS OF THE CITY OF
2 BESSEMER CITY ON ITS ONE-HUNDREDTH ANNIVERSARY.

3 Whereas, the City of Bessemer City in Gaston County will be celebrating 100
4 years of incorporation on March 6, 1993; and

5 Whereas, the founders of the City of Bessemer City made great contributions
6 to the city; and

7 Whereas, the city was named for Sir Henry Bessemer, who lived from 1813
8 until 1898 and who discovered the process for making steel from cast iron; and

9 Whereas, the City of Bessemer City is known for producing textiles,
10 machinery, and chemicals; and

11 Whereas, the citizens of the City of Bessemer City have been actively
12 preparing for the city's centennial celebration;

13 Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Senate:

14 Section 1. The General Assembly honors the founders of the City of
15 Bessemer City and joins the city's citizens in celebrating the city's one-hundredth
16 anniversary.

17 Sec. 2. The Principal Clerk of the Senate shall transmit a certified copy of
18 this resolution to the Mayor of the City of Bessemer City and to the Chair of the Gaston
19 County Board of County Commissioners.

20 Sec. 3. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
