A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OVER WHICH THE DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION IS REQUIRED TO SOLICIT PROPOSALS FOR  
PROFESSIONAL OR SPECIALIZED SERVICES CONTRACTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 136-28.1(f) reads as rewritten:

"(f) The Department of Transportation is required to solicit proposals under rules and regulations published by the Department of Transportation for all contracts for professional engineering services and other kinds of professional or specialized services necessary in connection with highway construction or repair that are over ~~ten thousand dollars (\$10,000)~~ twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000). The right to reject any and all proposals is reserved to the Board of Transportation, but the Board of Transportation may consult with the Advisory Budget Commission before awarding any such contract."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
