### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO MAKE EMPLOYEES PERSONALLY LIABLE FOR COSTS3 ASSOCIATED WITH STATE CONTRACTS ENTERED INTO IN VIOLATION
- 4 OF PURCHASE AND CONTRACT LAWS AND RULES.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
  - Section 1. G.S. 143-58 reads as rewritten:

## 7 "§ 143-58. Contracts contrary to provisions of Article made void.

If any department, institution or agency of the State government, required by this 8 9 Article and the rules adopted pursuant thereto applying to the purchase or lease of supplies, materials, equipment, printing or services through the Secretary of 10 Administration, or any nonstate institution, agency or instrumentality duly authorized or 11 required to make purchases through the Department of Administration, shall contract for 12 the purchase or lease of such supplies, materials, equipment, printing or services 13 contrary to the provisions of this Article or the rules made hereunder, such contract shall 14 be void and of no effect. If any such State or nonstate department, institution, agency or 15 instrumentality purchases any supplies, materials, equipment, printing or services 16 17 contrary to the provisions of this Article or the rules made hereunder, the employee who 18 violated the provisions of this Article or the rules made hereunder, the executive officer of such department, institution, agency or instrumentality shall be instrumentality, or both 19 20 may be held personally liable for the costs thereof."

21 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993, and applies to acts and 22 omissions occurring after that date.
