A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT VOTER REGISTRATION SHALL BE THE SOLE
CRITERIA FOR ALLOCATING VOTING MACHINES AMONG PRECINCTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Article 14 of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes is amended by
adding a new section to read:

"§ 163-166. Allocation of voting systems.

In allocating to precincts voting systems as defined in G.S. 163-160.1, the sole
criteria shall be voter registration in the precinct."

Sec. 2. This act is effective with respect to elections conducted on or after
January 1, 1994.
