SENATE BILL 901

Short Title: Bicycle Clinging Prohibited.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT BICYCLISTS AND OTHERS FROM CLINGING TO
OTHER VEHICLES WHILE ON A ROADWAY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
section to read:

"§ 20-171.3. Clinging to motor vehicles prohibited.

(a) No person riding on any bicycle, moped, coaster, roller skates, in-line skates,
skateboard, sled, or toy vehicle shall attach himself or what he is riding to any motor
vehicle while on a roadway.

(b) This section shall not prohibit attaching a bicycle trailer or bicycle semitrailer
to a bicycle if that trailer or semitrailer has been designed for attachment to a bicycle."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993.
