A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA INTERLOC PROGRAM, A GRANT PROGRAM TO ENCOURAGE LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION TO ACT JOINTLY TO PROVIDE PROGRAMS OR SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education, Aid to Local School Administrative Units, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the North Carolina Interloc Program, a program to provide grants to encourage two or more county school administrative units to act jointly to provide programs and services to their students.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
