"TO REQUIRE THAT ALL STATE AGENCIES ISSUING BUSINESS LICENSES OR PRIVILEGE LICENSES REPORT QUARTERLY TO THE BUSINESS LICENSE INFORMATION OFFICE THE NUMBER OF LICENSES ISSUED BY CATEGORY." Adds new GS 147-54.18 as title indicates. Effective for licenses issued on and after July 1, 1993. Introduced by Spears.
