G.S. 14-52, as amended by Section 1151 of Chapter 539 of the 4 1993 Session Laws, reads as rewritten: "§ 14-52. (Effective January 1, 1995) Punishment for burglary. Burglary in the first degree shall be punishable as a Class D-C felony, and burglary 7 in the second degree shall be punishable as a Class G felony." Sec. 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 1995, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date. 10
