A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MAKE FIRST DEGREE BURGLARY A CLASS C FELONY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 14-52, as amended by Section 1151 of Chapter 539 of the 1993 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"§ 14-52. (Effective January 1, 1995) Punishment for burglary.

Burglary in the first degree shall be punishable as a Class ~~D~~C felony, and burglary in the second degree shall be punishable as a Class G felony."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 1995, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
