AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CRIME
CONTROL AND PUBLIC SAFETY FOR THE CREATION OF VIOLENT
PREDATOR PROSECUTION TEAMS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the
1994-95 fiscal year for the development and coordination of statewide Violent Predator
Prosecution Teams.
Sec. 2. The development of the Violent Predator Prosecution Teams by the
Department of Crime Control and Public Safety shall include:
(1) Establishing criteria and procedures for targeting statewide predatory
violent criminals for arrest and prosecution; and
(2) Interfacing with the Department of Justice, district attorneys, and State
and local law enforcement officials in the development of the Violent
Predator Prosecution Teams and in identifying, arresting, and

prosecuting predatory violent criminals statewide.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
