A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CONTINUE THE
3 MULTI JURISDICTIONAL DRUG TASK FORCES LOCATED WITHIN THE
4 FIRST CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT OF NORTH CAROLINA.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
7 Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000)
8 for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be used as grants to the multijurisdictional drug task
9 forces operating within the First Congressional District comprised of Beaufort, Bertie,
10 Bladen, Chowan, Columbus, Craven, Cumberland, Duplin, Edgecombe, Gates, Greene,
11 Halifax, Hertford, Jones, Lenior, Martin, Nash, New Hanover, Northampton,
12 Pasquotank, Pender, Perquimans, Pitt, Vance, Warren, Washington, Wayne, and Wilson
13 Counties. Only local units of government shall be eligible to receive grants which shall
14 be awarded pursuant to guidelines adopted by the Department of Crime Control and
15 Public Safety. A minimum cash match of twenty-five percent (25%) shall be required.

16 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
