A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR
VARIOUS PURPOSES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Justice the sum of nine million eight hundred ninety-seven thousand seven hundred seventeen dollars (\$9,897,717) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for operating funds for various purposes:

- (1) Three capital case litigation positions in the Criminal Division;
- (2) Two special investigators and 26 field agents in the State Bureau of Investigation (SBI);
- (3) Upgrade Automated Fingerprint Identification System;
- (4) Expand Division of Criminal Information computer capacity;
- (5) Matching funds for federal Bullet Proof Program grants;
- (6) Upgrade access to North Carolina Information Highway;
- (7) One SBI forensic firearms analyst;
- (8) Ten SBI positions to support Automated Fingerprint Identification System;
- (9) Eight criminal justice instructors and two support positions for North Carolina Justice Academy;
- (10) Four and one half positions for integrating North Carolina Information Highway into law enforcement training system;
- (11) Five positions at North Carolina Justice Academy to improve research support;

- 1 (12) Ten support positions for North Carolina Justice Academy health and
2 safety improvements;
- 3 (13) Two positions for the Sheriffs' Education and Training Standards
4 Commission; and
- 5 (14) One Attorney II Law Enforcement Liaison position to assist in local
6 drug law enforcement efforts.
- 7 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
