A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE CAPITAL FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
JUSTICE FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Justice the sum of thirteen million five hundred sixty-seven thousand one hundred dollars (\$13,567,100) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for capital projects for the State Bureau of Investigation to include reestablishing funding for the completion of the planned State Bureau of Investigation facility and repairs and renovations at existing facilities.

(b) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Justice the sum of nine million six hundred ninety-four thousand two hundred dollars (\$9,694,200) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for new construction, repairs, and renovations at the North Carolina Justice Academy.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
