Section 1. A city may by ordinance establish during specified nighttime hours a curfew applicable to minors by prohibiting minors from traversing, travelling, strolling, wandering, loitering, playing, or otherwise going or remaining in or upon streets, roads, or highways or in public places or upon private property held open to the public during those hours.

- Sec. 2. This act applies to the City of Charlotte only.
- 11 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
