7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	Section 1. Chapter 153A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
9	Article to read:
10	" <u>ARTICLE 21.</u>
11	''FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION.
12	" <u>§ 153A-406. Regulation of pistols or other firearms.</u>
13	A county shall not impose special taxation on, enact any ordinance pertaining to, or
14	regulate in any manner the ownership, registration, purchase, sale, transfer,
15	transportation, or possession of pistols or other firearms, ammunition for pistols or other
16	firearms, or components of pistols or other firearms, except as otherwise provided by
17	federal or State law.
18	" <u>§ 153A-407. Prohibitions or regulations allowed.</u>
19	This Article does not prohibit a county from:
20	(1) Prohibiting or regulating conduct with a pistol or other firearm that is a
21	criminal offense under State law.
22	(2) <u>Prohibiting or regulating the transportation, carrying, or possession of</u>
23	pistols and other firearms by employees of the county in the course of
24	their employment.

This act becomes effective October 15, 1994, and applies to any 26 ordinances or regulations adopted on or after that date. 27
