A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ALLOW THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION TO USE EXISTING SPACE MORE EFFICIENTLY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Correction the sum of one million six hundred thirty-nine thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,639,500) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to allow the Department to house 500 additional inmates in currently existing space.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
