A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE EXPANSION OF THE
CORRECTION ENTERPRISES PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Correction the sum of thirty-nine million five hundred nineteen thousand one hundred dollars (\$39,519,100) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to expand the Correction Enterprises program to ensure participation by all inmates who would benefit from the skills training provided by the program.

Sec. 2. The Governor shall ensure that all eligible inmates are employed in the Correction Enterprises program by January 1, 1995, and that, by that date, the Correction Enterprises program is fully self-funded and will require no State funds from that date forward.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
