A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REDUCE GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS BY ONE PERCENT  
2 OTHER THAN TO THE DEPARTMENTS OF JUSTICE, CORRECTION, AND  
3 CRIME CONTROL AND PUBLIC SAFETY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Except for appropriations made by that section to the Department  
7 of Justice, the Department of Correction, or to the Department of Crime Control and  
8 Public Safety, all General Fund appropriations for fiscal year 1993-94 made by Section  
9 3 of Chapter 321 of the 1993 Session Laws, the Current Operations Appropriations Act  
10 of 1993, are reduced by one percent (1%).

11 Sec. 2. The reductions taken by Section 1 of this act shall be applied as  
12 follows:

- 13 (1) By the Governor to the Office of the Governor and to the departments  
14 established by Chapter 143B of the General Statutes and to any  
15 reserves not yet allocated;
- 16 (2) By the Lieutenant Governor to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor;
- 17 (3) By each other member of the Council of State to the Department they  
18 are head of;
- 19 (4) By the Executive Secretary-Director of the State Board of Elections to  
20 the State Board of Elections;
- 21 (5) By the Legislative Services Commission to the General Assembly;
- 22 (6) By the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina to The  
23 University of North Carolina System;

- 1           (7) By the State Board of Community Colleges to the Department of  
2           Community Colleges and all community colleges;
- 3           (8) By the Administrative Officer of the Courts to the Judicial  
4           Department;
- 5           (9) By the State Board of Education to the Department of Public  
6           Instruction, State Aid to Local School Administrative Units, and the  
7           State Board of Education;
- 8           (10) By the State Controller for the Office of the State Controller;
- 9           (11) By the Rules Review Commission for the Rules Review Commission;  
10          and
- 11          (12) By the Director of the Office of Administrative Hearings for the Office  
12          of Administrative Hearings.
- 13          Sec. 3. This act does not apply to Local Government Shared Revenue and to  
14          Debt Service.
- 15          Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
