AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH A TEEN COURT MODEL
PROGRAM FOR THE TWENTY-EIGHTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT.

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department for the Buncombe County Dispute Settlement Center the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to develop and implement a "teen court" model program, which program is to be made available to all junior and senior high school students in the 28th Judicial District for the purpose of handling problems that develop at school but that have not been turned over to the juvenile authorities.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
