A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO FULLY IMPLEMENT THE UNFUNDED  
2 PARTS OF THE BASIC EDUCATION PROGRAM THAT WILL  
3 SIGNIFICANTLY AID IN REDUCING CRIME.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Aid to Local  
7 School Administrative Units the sum of fourteen million seven hundred thirty-two  
8 thousand eight hundred eighty dollars (\$14,732,880) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to fully  
9 fund all the school counselors required by the Basic Education Program.

10 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Aid to Local School  
11 Administrative Units the sum of nine million one hundred thirty-seven thousand four  
12 hundred dollars (\$9,137,400) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to fully fund all the school  
13 social workers required by the Basic Education Program.

14 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Aid to Local School  
15 Administrative Units the sum of nine million nine hundred sixty-six thousand three  
16 hundred sixty dollars (\$9,966,360) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to fully fund all the  
17 school psychologists required by the Basic Education Program.

18 Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Aid to Local School  
19 Administrative Units the sum of sixty-five million one hundred twenty-four thousand  
20 six hundred five dollars (\$65,124,605) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to fully fund all the  
21 teachers required by the Basic Education Program to reduce class size in kindergarten  
22 through the third grade.

1           Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Aid to Local School  
2 Administrative Units the sum of thirty million seven hundred thirty-two thousand two  
3 hundred forty-seven dollars (\$30,732,247) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to fully fund all  
4 the teacher assistants required by the Basic Education Program in kindergarten through  
5 the third grade.

6           Sec. 6. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
