A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXPEDITE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE STATE-COUNTY  
CRIMINAL JUSTICE PARTNERSHIP ACT AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS  
TO SUPPORT THE PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 534 of the 1993 Session Laws reads as  
rewritten:

"Sec. 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 1994. Grants administered under this  
act shall become effective ~~July~~ January 1, 1995. The Department of Correction may use  
funds available to support the administration of the State-County Criminal Justice  
Partnership program effective January 1, 1994."

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
Correction the sum of six million five hundred thousand dollars (\$6,500,000) for the  
1994-95 fiscal year to support the implementation and administration of the State-  
County Criminal Justice Partnership program.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective January 1, 1995.
