2	AN ACT TO EXPEDITE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE STATE-COUNTY
3	CRIMINAL JUSTICE PARTNERSHIP ACT AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS
4	TO SUPPORT THE PROGRAM.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 534 of the 1993 Session Laws reads as
7	rewritten:
8	"Sec. 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 1994. Grants administered under this
9	act shall become effective July January 1, 1995. The Department of Correction may use
10	funds available to support the administration of the State-County Criminal Justice
11	Partnership program effective January 1, 1994."
12	Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
13	Correction the sum of six million five hundred thousand dollars (\$6,500,000) for the
14	1994-95 fiscal year to support the implementation and administration of the State-
15	County Criminal Justice Partnership program.
16	Sec. 3. This act becomes effective January 1, 1995.

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
