A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO RAISE THE AGE OF UNDISCIPLINED JUVENILES TO EIGHTEEN
YEARS OF AGE IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 7A-517(28) reads as rewritten:

"(28) Undisciplined Juvenile. —~~A juvenile less than 16 years of age who is unlawfully absent from school; or who is regularly disobedient to his parent, guardian, or custodian and beyond their disciplinary control; or who is regularly found in places where it is unlawful for a juvenile to be; or who has run away from home.~~—A juvenile who is:

a. Less than 16 years of age who is unlawfully absent from school; or

b. Less than 18 years of age who:

1. Is regularly disobedient to and beyond the disciplinary control of the juvenile's parent, guardian, or custodian;

2. Is regularly found in places where it is unlawful for a juvenile to be; or

3. Has run away from home."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994, and applies to causes of action arising on or after that date.
