2 AN ACT TO CREATE A DRUG-FREE PUBLIC HOUSING ZONE BY PROVIDING  
3 AN ENHANCED PENALTY FOR DRUG OFFENSES NEAR PUBLIC  
4 HOUSING.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 90-95(e) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

7 "(10) Any person 21 years of age or older who commits an offense under  
8 G.S. 90-95(a)(1) on property owned, leased, or managed by a housing  
9 authority (as defined in G.S. 157-3) or within 300 feet of the boundary  
10 of real property owned, leased, or managed by a housing authority  
11 shall be punished as a Class E felon. For purposes of this subdivision,  
12 the transfer of less than five grams of marijuana for no remuneration  
13 shall not constitute a delivery in violation of G.S. 90-95(a)(1)."

14 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994, and applies to acts  
15 committed on or after that date.
