S 1 SENATE BILL 104 Short Title: Feticide Crime. (Public) Sponsors: Senator Ballance. Referred to: Juveniles/Prevention February 15, 1994 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO CREATE THE CRIME OF FETICIDE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Article 6 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by 4 adding a new section to read: "§ 14-17.2. Feticide. Offense. A person is guilty of feticide if, other than in the course of a lawful 7 (a) abortion pursuant to G.S. 14-45.1, the person intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly commits an act that causes the death of a viable fetus by injuring the mother or fetus and the act is one that would be murder if it resulted in the death of the mother. A fetus is 10 presumed to be viable six months or more after the date of its conception. 12 Punishment. Feticide is punishable as a Class E felony." Sec. 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 1995, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date. 14
