A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A STUDY TO DETERMINE WHETHER LONG-TERM
2 CRIME PREVENTION CAN BE EFFECTED BY PROVIDING CERTAIN
3 INCENTIVES TO FAMILIES RECEIVING AID TO FAMILIES WITH
4 DEPENDENT CHILDREN TO ACT RESPONSIBLY IN RAISING THEIR
5 CHILDREN.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. The General Assembly may study the issue of whether long-term
9 crime prevention can be effected by providing incentives to families receiving Aid To
10 Families With Dependent Children to act responsibly in raising their children.

11 The study shall consider:

- 12 (1) The feasibility of providing incentives;
13 (2) What type of incentives are appropriate;
14 (3) What standards should be used in determining the allocation of
15 incentives; and
16 (4) What penalties, if any, should be imposed for failing to comply with
17 the standards.

18 The General Assembly may direct that these issues be studied by any other
19 legislative study commission studying welfare reform.

20 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
