A SENATE RESOLUTION REQUESTING MEMBERS OF CONGRESS
REPRESENTING NORTH CAROLINA TO CONSIDER, SPONSOR, AND PUSH
FOR ENACTMENT OF CONSTITUTIONAL LEGISLATION LIMITING
VIOLENCE ON TELEVISION.

5 Be it resolved by the Senate:

6 Section 1. The Senate of North Carolina finds that depiction of unlawful acts 7 of violence on television is at a grossly excessive level. Such depictions, especially 8 when viewed by children, foster the attitude that criminal acts of violence are normal 9 and should be a way to resolve personal problems and disputes.

10 Sec. 2. The Senate of the State of North Carolina requests the members of 11 the Congress of the United States representing North Carolina to consider, sponsor, and 12 push for enactment of legislation which will effectively while still constitutionally 13 reduce the depiction on television of unlawful acts of violence.

14 Sec. 3. The Senate of the State of North Carolina requests each member of 15 Congress representing North Carolina to respond in writing what that member can do 16 and is doing to carry out the request of the Senate. Such response shall be directed to 17 the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

18 Sec. 4. The Principal Clerk of the Senate shall transmit a copy of this 19 resolution to each member of Congress representing North Carolina.

20 Sec. 5. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
