A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE ALL STATE AND NON-STATE AGENCIES THAT
2 RECEIVE FUNDS FOR IMPLEMENTING ANTICRIME INITIATIVES TO
3 REPORT TO THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE CORRECTIONS OVERSIGHT
4 COMMITTEE.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. Every agency of the State and every non-State agency or entity
8 that receives State funds appropriated in the Extra Session 1994 for implementing
9 program initiatives for reducing crime shall report to the Joint Legislative Corrections
10 Oversight Committee at its first meeting and quarterly thereafter. The report shall
11 provide information on the expenditure of the funds, program implementation progress,
12 and results to date. The purpose of these reports is to provide the General Assembly
13 and the citizens of this State with information on the progress and success of initiatives
14 developed to reduce crime in North Carolina's communities.

15 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
