Section 1. Every agency of the State and every non-State agency or entity that receives State funds appropriated in the Extra Session 1994 for implementing program initiatives for reducing crime shall report to the Joint Legislative Corrections Oversight Committee at its first meeting and quarterly thereafter. The report shall provide information on the expenditure of the funds, program implementation progress, and results to date. The purpose of these reports is to provide the General Assembly and the citizens of this State with information on the progress and success of initiatives developed to reduce crime in North Carolina's communities.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
