2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE EARLIER IMPLEMENTATION OF

- 3 THE STRUCTURED SENTENCING ACT.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 6 Correction, Division of Adult Probation and Parole, the sum of thirty-one million four 7 hundred thousand dollars (\$31,400,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to provide 8 supervision of community and intermediate sanctions.

9 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 10 Human Resources the sum of four million six hundred twenty thousand dollars 11 (\$4,620,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to provide substance abuse treatment services 12 to offenders sentenced to community or intermediate punishments.

13 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial 14 Department the sum of two million four hundred forty-seven thousand seven hundred 15 fifty-nine dollars (\$2,447,759) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for legal assistance to collect 16 prior record information, for private counsel for indigents, and for automation needs.

17 Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial 18 Department the sum of one million eight hundred thirty-two thousand eight hundred 19 seventy-five dollars (\$1,832,875) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for expansion of the 20 community penalties programs.

Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of one hundred ten thousand dollars
(\$110,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for expansion of the community service program.
Sec. 6. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
