**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES, DIVISION OF AGING, FOR CAPITAL EXPENSES OF SENIOR CENTERS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Aging, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and to provide funds for Senior Centers statewide for renovations, repair, upkeep, and construction. To be eligible to receive funds, a senior center must provide a ten percent (10%) match.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
