**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF PUBLIC SCHOOL  
TEXTBOOKS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year. The State Board of Education shall allocate these funds to local school administrative units for the purchase of textbooks.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
