AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR EXCEPTIONAL CHILDREN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of eighteen million five hundred seventy-five thousand three hundred sixty-three dollars (\$18,575,363) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of thirty-seven million one hundred fifty thousand seven hundred twenty-six dollars (\$37,150,726) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to increase the funding formula for children with special needs except for academically gifted children.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of five million seven hundred sixteen thousand six hundred thirty-seven dollars (\$5,716,637) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of eleven million four hundred thirty-three thousand two hundred seventy-four dollars (\$11,433,274) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to increase the funding formula for children with special needs who are academically gifted to four percent (4%) of average daily membership rather than three and nine-tenths percent (3.9%).

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
