**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION TO CONDUCT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STUDY  
OF THE O'NEAL-ROCKWOOD CONNECTOR IN THE CITY OF BURLINGTON.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the Highway Fund to the Department of Transportation the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year for the Department of Transportation to conduct an environmental impact study of the proposed O'Neal-Rockwood Connector in the City of Burlington.

The Department of Transportation shall report the results of this environmental impact study to the 1996 Session of the General Assembly before beginning construction of the O'Neal-Rockwood Connector project.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
